QUESTIONS TO PREPARE FOR

- Why do you want to get into this trade?
- What do you know about what the job actually involves?
- How will you get to work each day?
- Tell me about a time you worked in a team or stuck at something hard.
- Do you have any experience, a pre-apprenticeship, or your white card?
- Are you okay with early starts, physical work and TAFE?

BRING THESE WITH YOU

- A tidy one-page resume (two copies)
- Your white card and any licences or tickets
- ID and your contact details
- A pen and something to write on

SMART QUESTIONS TO ASK THEM

- What does a normal day look like for a first-year here?
- What sort of work do you mainly do (residential, commercial, industrial)?
- How is TAFE handled, day release or block release?
- What are you looking for in an apprentice?

ON THE DAY

- Turn up early, clean and tidy
- Firm handshake, eye contact, phone away
- Be honest about what you can and cannot do yet
- Show you are reliable and keen to learn
